What is the Washington Service Corps?

The WSC is an AmeriCorps project that places full-time stipend volunteers in local nonprofits, schools, government agencies, and faith-based organizations across the state of Washington. Our members serve for 10.5 months in programs that tutor to children, restore natural habitats, provide health and nutrition education, address financial literacy and poverty relief—just to name a few. Whatever your interests, there's an WSC AmeriCorps position for you!

What are the benefits of serving with the WSC?

Every member serving with the WSC receives:

- A monthly living stipend of \$1,202.86* (before taxes)
- Basic health insurance coverage
- An education award worth \$5,815* that can be used to pay for future schooling costs or existing student loan debt

* Stipend and education award amounts subject to change for each service term

How do I apply for a position with the WSC?

WSC positions require applicants to be at least 17 years old with a high school diploma or GED.
