The Washington Service Corps is one of the few AmeriCorps programs in the nation that offers so many different fields to serve in. Help local non-profits, schools, government agencies, tribal nations and faith-based organizations meet community needs. Try environmental stewardship or a chance to help students improve academically; help adults improve their health, prepare for disasters, advance their careers or increase their technology, financial and basic skills; or provide Veterans with opportunities to engage in their community through volunteering.



- Monthly stipend of about \$1,332* before deductions and withholdings.
- Basic health insurance (not including vision coverage).
- Possible assistance with childcare costs.
- Upon successful term completion receive a \$6,095* education award (10.5-month positions) that can be used for future schooling or to pay off existing qualified student loan debt .
- And many other benefits.

**Stipend and education award amounts subject to change for each service term*

- Must be at least 17 years of age
- Must be must be a U.S. citizen, national or lawful permanent resident alien.
- Must be willing to make a commitment of 10.5 months and 1,700 hours of service. Most projects are based on a 40-hour week (8 hours in service daily, Monday through Friday).
- Must pass background checks
- Our program year begins in the Fall
